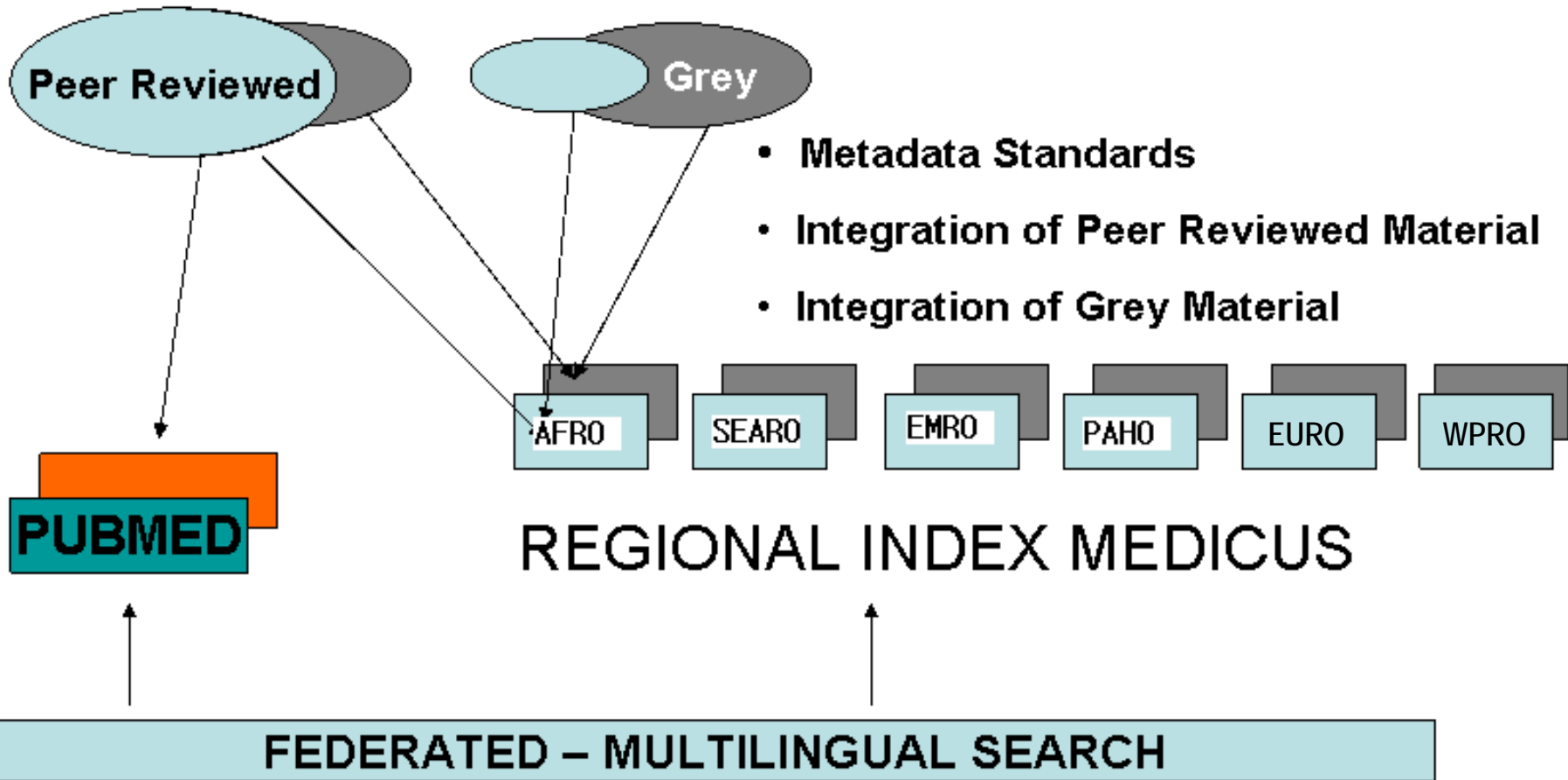

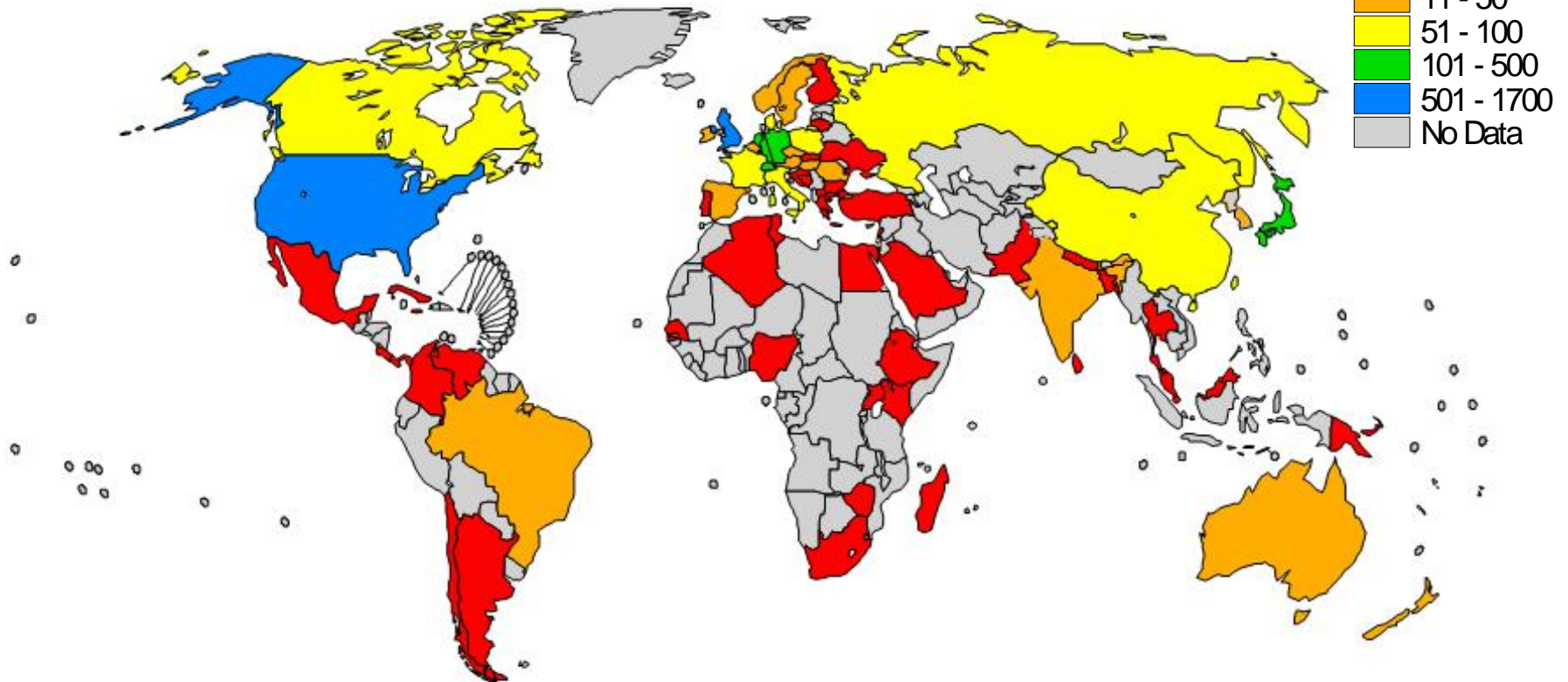

Western Pacific Region Index Medicus (WPRIM)

The Western Pacific Region Index Medicus (WPRIM) is a joint project of the WHO Regional Office for the Western Pacific and Member States in the Region. This is one of the Region's contributions to the Global Health Library (see page 5).

The goal of WPRIM is to establish an online index of medical and health journals published in Member States.

The objectives of WPRIM are:

- To index selected medical/health journals in Member States of the WHO Western Pacific Region;
- To create a bibliographic database containing records linked to abstracts or full texts of articles; and
- To improve the quality of journal publishing in Member States.

WPRIM will be made accessible along with the medical literature indexes of other WHO Regions under the Global Health Library platform.

Dr Seo's Thoughts on WPRIM

Dr Jeong-Wook Seo, a Professor of the Department of Pathology and Director of the Medical Library of the Seoul National University, has been a key supporter of WPRIM since its inception.

Why do you believe that WPRIM is an essential project?

The most significant and relevant advances in health research start with access to health knowledge of one's own country and knowledge sharing with the rest of the world. Advanced research may not be applicable in developing countries, which have specific health priorities. National research data are often not used because they are not readily available. WPRIM should respond to this knowledge gap.

What is your vision of WPRIM?

Our first goal is to aggregate our regional research information to build a significant amount of data from national and regional resources. Our second goal is to upgrade the quality of this information by circulating it for review by peers and to have it cited by our fellow researchers. Our third and most important goal is to be aware of our own knowledge resources and exchange these resources to further improve work towards disease prevention, health protection and health for all.



Technical Support from the Republic of Korea

The Korean Association of Medical Journal Editors (KAMJE) visited the Philippines and met with local WPRIM partners and staff of the WHO Regional Office for the Western Pacific to discuss project strategies and activities. They also offered the use of their customized software for the WPRIM database.

A WPRO staff member and an IT employee of the Philippine Council for Health Research and Development trained in the Republic of Korea from 25 June to 8 July 2006 on the KoreaMed System.

‘아태 의학학술지 편집인협의회’ 발족

11개국 연구논문 접근성 높여...초대회장 함창곡 교수

아시아·태평양 지역 국가들의 의학학술지 정보를 공유할 수 있는 네트워크가 구축됐다.

한국·일본·호주 등 아태 지역 11개 국가 의학학술지 편집인들은 4-5일 서울 코엑스와 서울대에서 ‘아시아태평양 의학학술지 편집인협의회(Asia Pacific Association of Medical Journal Editors, APAME)’ 창립총회를 열었다.

이 협의회가 발족함에 따라 이 지역 의학 정보에 대한 접근이 한층 쉬워지게 됐다. 최근 보건 의학 정보가 빠르게 발전하고 이를 공유할 수 있는 기술도 업그레이드 되고 있으나, 아·태 지역

국가들이 미국 등의 의학학술지 정보 접근에서 배제되는 면이 있었고 선진국과 개발도상국 간 정보 격차가 점점 심화되는 문제점이 지적돼 왔다.

총회에서는 초대 회장에 함창곡 한양대 명예교수를, 사무총장에 서정욱 서울의대 교수를 선임했다. 6일에는 대한의사협회 회관에서 헌판식을 열었다.

함창곡 회장은 “아태 의학학술지 편집인협의회는 회원국 연구자들 사이의 커뮤니케이션과 정보 교환 및 협력에 주력할 예정”이라며 “특히 개도국이 밀집된 지역에서 사업을 많이 시행해 이들 국가들을 지원하고 참여를 활

성화하겠다”고 말했다.

학술지 국제화 지혜 나눈다

지구촌 시대, 국내학술지로 경쟁력이 없다.

SCI나 메디라인에 등재하기 위한 첫판문이 '국제학술지'를 대상으로 할 정도로 '국내학술지'는 갈수록 설 공간이 좁아지고 있는 것이다. 이같은 현상

은 우리나라뿐 아니라 아·태지역 많은 나라들의 현실이기도 하다.

우리나라는 현재 200여편에 달하는 의학 관련 학술잡지 가운데 10%인 19편 만이 메디라인에 등재돼 있다. 이것은 아직도 열악한 수준이지만 최근 몇년간에 걸친 대한의학학술지 편집인협의회(KAMJE)의 국제적 활동 성과물들로 성공적인 출발을 하고 있다는 평가를 받고 있다.

이같은 KAMJE의 성공사례를 발표하고 아·태 각국의 의학학술잡지의 현실을 논의하는 단체가 우리나라 서울에서 창립총회를 갖고 출범한다.

5월 4~5일 서울 코엑스 그랜드컨퍼런스룸과 서울대 멀티미디어 강의실에서 열리는 아시아·태평양 의학학술지 편집인협의회(APAME)가 바로 그것으로 '국내학술지의 국제화'를 목표로 한 학술단체로 힘찬 새 출발을 하는 것이다.

이번 단체 결성은 국내학술지에 외국학자들이 투고를 하도록 하고 한·중·일 비교연구 같은 연구기법·연구자료·저자 등을 넓혀나가도록 하여

공극적으로 국제학술지로 역할을 하도록 하는데 있다.

아태 지역은 일본·호주·뉴질랜드·싱가포르의 경우 국내학술잡지라도 대부분 국제화가 돼 있어 우리보다 한발 앞서 있다. 우리나라와 중국은 중간단계이고, 기타 아시아국가는 전혀 국제화가 이뤄지지 않고 있다.

그럼에도 불구하고 우리나라의 주도로 창립총회를 열고 아·태지역의 리더로 부상하고 있는 것은 KAMJE의 성공적 출발에 기인한 점도 있지만 서울의대 조수현 교수 등 이 분야 의학자들의 전방위적 활동이 크게 작용했기 때문이다.

이번 창립총회에는 12개국 200여명의 학자가 모여 본회의와 분임토론에서 앞으로 APAME가 나갈 방향 등에 대해 구체적으로 설정하게 된다.

특히 외국인자(24명)와 국내 의학자 120여명이 분임토의에 참석, 정관·학술활동·재정 등을 정하고 어떻게 운영할 것인가와 상호심사, 출판윤리, 편집인의 역할을 논의할 예정이어서 의학계의 관심을 집중시키고 있다.

이날 함창국 회장이 APAME의 창립 의의와 운영전략을 주제로 기조연설을 하며, 호주의 니콜라복스리 교수가 근거중심의 임상, 중국 왕 데박사가 과학저널 편집에 있어서의 역할과 상호심사, 차기회장에 내정된 말레이시아의 존아로키아 사미 교수가 편집자의 역할과 상호심사를 각각 발표한다. 우리나라는 한 학회당 3명씩 참석하게 된다.

“학술지 경쟁력 강화 절실”

각국 국내저널 공유팬 의학계 진일보 할 것

“2005년 WHO 세계보건도서 관 활동으로 의학학술계 지도자가 모여 지속적인 교류로 학술잡지의 경쟁력 강화 등을 논의 하자는 의견이 있은 후 서·태지역과 아시아를 합친 지역 편집인 모임 결성이 검토됐습니다.

이번에 창립하는 이 단체는 임기가 한정된 회장이나 이사장보다는 대부분의 학회에서 관례적으로 4~5년 또는 그 이상 역할을 하고 있는 편집인을 대상으로 하고 있습니다.”

서정욱 APAME 사무총장(서울의대 병리학과)은 우리나라에 사무국을 둔 국제학술단체가 창립됨으로써 우리나라 의학계의 위상이 강화되고 연구와 발표에 있어서 한층 더 도약할 것으로 기대된다고 밝혔다.

특히 의학학술지의 경우 일본·호주 등의 국제화에 뒤져 있지만 아·태지역에서 주도적으로 단체를 이끌게 된 것은 의미가 크다고 강조했다.

또 “아시아 조류독감 연구 시 많은 국가가 자국의 학술지여서

한국에서는 살펴볼 수가 없다”며, 각국의 국내학술지를 국제 용으로 발전시키면 의학연구의 진일보를 이룰 수 있다는 것이 KAMJE의 시각이라고 소개했다. 그렇게 되면 언어장벽은 있지만 연구결과가 논문으로 작성돼 기록으로 남아 국제적으로도 인용될 수 있다는 것이다.

그는 아·태지역 스스로 국제학술지를 평가할 수 있는 메커니즘을 만드는 계기가 된다는 점에서 의의가 있다고 밝히고 이 단체는 학술지 평가와 업그레이드, 교육사업, 편집인·의학연구 등 학회간 교류의 장이 될 것이라고 강조했다.

Second WPRIM Meeting in Seoul, Republic of Korea

The Second Meeting on the Western Pacific Region Index Medicus (WPRIM) was held at the Hoam Faculty Convention Center, Seoul National University, Seoul, Republic of Korea from 21 to 23 November 2007. The meeting was attended by national focal persons of WPRIM, medical journal editors and other professionals from selected Member States of WHO in the Western Pacific Region. Discussions were focused on the progress and development of WPRIM, plans and activities relating to advocacy and fund-raising, capacity-building and the proposal for the establishment of a regional editors' association.



The recommendations made during the meeting were:

1. A mission statement for WPRIM should be formulated.
2. Cambodia, Lao PDR, Papua New Guinea and the Pacific Island countries should be encouraged to participate in the WPRIM and Global Health Library (GHL) initiatives.
3. Chairs of National Journal Selection Committees should be formally appointed as members of the Regional Journal Selection Committee (RJSC).

WPRIM Regional Journal Selection Committee

The representatives of the countries' National Journal Selection Committees (NJSCs) were present during the first meeting of the Regional Journal Selection Committee (RJSC) on 21 November 2007 in Seoul, Republic of Korea. During the meeting, the terms of reference of the RJSC and the journal selection guidelines were presented.

The first RJSC meeting was attended by Dr Dai Tao and Mr Qian Qing (China), Dr Kichiro Tsutani (Japan), Dr Jeong-Wook Seo, Dr Jung-Gi Im, Dr Sung-Tae Hong (Republic of Korea), Dr John T. Anokiasamy (Malaysia), Dr Badrakh Burmasjav (Mongolia), Dr Jose Ma. C. Avila (Philippines), Mr Nguyen Tuan Khoa (Viet Nam), and WHO/WPRO Secretariat.

The RJSC has provisionally approved 212 journals recommended by the NJSCs pending the completion of all the required improvements.

The members of the Committee recommended that all journals included in WPRIM should have English titles or an English translation of the original title and that the WPRIM logo be affixed, preferably on the back cover of the approved journals with the mention "Indexed in WPRIM".

The initial composition of the RJSC that would function for a term of two years was also decided as follows:

- Chair – Director of the Institute of Medical Information, Chinese Academy of Medical Sciences (IMICAMS)

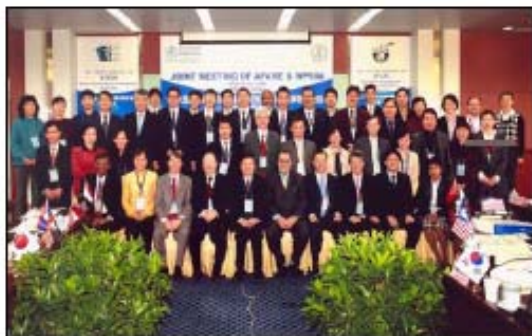

Joint Meeting of APAME and WPRIM Beijing, China

The Joint Meeting of the Asia Pacific Association of Medical Journal Editors (APAME) and Western Pacific Region Index Medicus (WPRIM) was held in Beijing, China from 18 to 21 November 2008. The Institute of Medical Information Chinese Academy of Medical Sciences (IMICAMS), co-organized the meeting attended by national focal persons of WPRIM, medical journal editors and other professionals from selected Member States of WHO in the Western Pacific Region.

The first two days were devoted to the WPRIM meeting where



presentations on the outcomes of previous WPRIM meetings; status of the WPRIM project, the Global Health Library, the EMRO Index Medicus, the e-Health conference in Bellagio, Italy and discussion on key WPRIM activities, in the areas of training, promotion, and funding were made. The evaluation and approval of candidate journals endorsed by the National Journal Selection Committee for inclusion in WPRIM were also tackled by the Regional Journal Selection Committee. The last two days were devoted to the APAME meeting where a presentation on the report of the first APAME meeting and website of APAME, discussions on the APAME constitution and logo, roles and activities of APAME committees, editing, peer-review, ethics, and other activities to scale up the quality of journal publishing were made.

Asia-Pacific Association of Medical Journal Editors: Updates



The Asia Pacific Association of Medical Journal Editors (APAME) presented its website, constitution and logo during the Joint Meeting of WPRIM and APAME from 18 to 21 November 2008 in Beijing, China. The constitution and logo were approved by the body unanimously.

The Chairs of the APAME Committees on Planning and Finance (Prof Chang Kok-Hahm), Education and IT (Prof Wilfred Peh), and Editorial Policy and Ethics (Dr Jose Avila) presented their reports. Dr Jeong-Wook Seo also presented the proposed planning activities for the Planning and Finance Committee. He also distributed application forms for individual and institutional membership of APAME.

The APAME Education Committee chaired by Prof Wilfred Peh have mentioned that requests from countries for future writing workshops are welcome and could be coordinated through him.

The Editorial Policy and Ethics Committee presented the editorial policies of APAME focusing on editorial responsibilities and proposed ethics guidelines. There were also discussions on peer review and publication ethics.

Among the recommendations formulated from this meeting were the following:

- (1) Application for membership from developing countries should be exempted from paying membership fees;
- (2) A list of volunteer reviewers and their field of expertise

in the Region should be compiled by APAME; and

(3) A scientific writing workshop shall be organized by APAME in Manila, Philippines in June 2009 in coordination with the Philippine Council for Health Research and Development (PCHRD) of the Department of Science and Technology.

Informal Consultation on WPRIM and GHIL and Scientific Writing Workshop in Manila

A one-day informal consultation on the Western Pacific Region Index Medicus (WPRIM) and the Global Health Library (GHIL) will be held in the WHO Regional Office for the Western Pacific in Manila on 17 June 2009.

The meeting aims to review the new WPRIM platform developed by the Institute of Medical Information, Chinese Academy of Medical Sciences (IMICAMS) and new WPRO GHIL portal. The meeting was organized to take advantage of the participation of some of the members of WPRIM and the Asia Pacific Association of Medical Journal Editors (APAME) who will attend the scientific writing workshop on 16 June 2009. The workshop will be organized by the Philippine Council for Health Research and Development (PCHRD) in cooperation with APAME and with the assistance from the Korean Association of Medical Journal Editors (KAMJE).

One of the agenda of the meeting is to also conduct an after action review of the scientific writing workshop and to discuss planned training activities in the Region. Representatives from China, Japan, Malaysia, Philippines, Republic of Korea, Singapore and Viet Nam will attend the meeting and workshop.

The scientific writing workshop for medical journal editors was one of the recommendations made during the Joint Meeting of APAME and WPRIM in Beijing, China in November 2009.

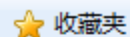

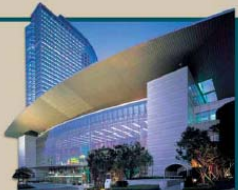

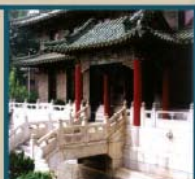
