
- 60% growth in membership

- Over 250 integrations in each sector of the research community









- European Commission and Science Europe both recommending ORCID iDs




ADOPTION IN ITALY






The ORCID Board is responsible for ensuring the organization is acting in the best interests of ORCID stakeholders.

- oversees the management of ORCID and its organizational performance, reviews high-level organizational goals and policies, makes highlevel decisions, reviews Executive Director performance, and serves as a community advocate for ORCID
- supported by the Executive Director and a fulltime professional staff, who are responsible for day-to-day operations and recommending goals and policies


Membership is important because:

 ORCID is a non-profit organization funded through organizational membership and fees. To sustain the registry and our mission of addressing the name ambiguity problem in scholarly communications, we rely on membership and funding from the research community.

Members receive these benefits:

- Access to the Member API, which facilitates registration, deposit, editing, and updating of Record Data and/or read Limited Access Data, with permission from an individual ORCID iD holder ("opt-in")
- Personalized technical support, integrated application user acceptance testing, a monthly newsletter, and invitations to public events hosted by ORCID
- Enter nominations for service on the ORCID Board
