Univariate analysis showed that IBS was associated with pet ownership, antibiotic usage, late dinner (> 21:00 hour) and consumption of Western meals, coffee(,) and bread.



 In this context, recognized mechanisms in IBS span a wide spectrum including gut dysmotility, low-grade inflammation, visceral hypersensitivity, changes of gut microbiome, infections, altered gut barrier function, genetic and psychosocial factors --- JNM

- "Those who have slow transit constipation might gain benefits from newer agents to restore colonic function(,) including serotoninergic enterokinetic agents, and intestinal secretagogues"
- if no comma then the function would include the next context
 - "agents" and "secretagogues" are "functions"



Confusing terminology

care/intervention/ therapy/treatment/

- "Care" preventive care, primary care
 - broad idea

- "Intervention" cardiac catheterization
 - specific

• "therapy" and "treatment" - synonymous

shall be/will be

...shall be... (cf: ...will be...)
used sometimes in UK English
in USA legal documents

AVOID "shall be"!

...can (could) be...

• "can" - ability or capability

"... our results shows that it can be..." $1\% \sim 99\%$

AVOID!

"using <u>absolute terms</u> such as:" 'always, never, sole'

"using imprecise terms such as:"
'might, could, can, rare, uncommon, usually, often, strongly, important, good, bad'

may be & maybe

may be (two words) might be, could be,
 or would be = possibly

maybe (one word) = probably

possible & probable

• Possible – it could happen < 50%

• **Probable** – more likely to happen > 50%

"...our results show that the outcome is **probably** more favorable.... "

who & whom

Current English: use who

Corroborate - agree with (확증하다)

Collaborate - work together (협력하다)

Number concept

few \(\bar{a} \) few

Incidence/Prevalence/Frequency

Prevalence

- proportion of cases in the population at a given time
- indicates the disease widespread

Incidence

- information on risk of contracting disease
- → prevalence = incidence × duration

Frequency number of occurrences of a repeating event per unit time

Location/Site

Location

- <u>particular</u>, <u>specific</u> point or place in physical space

Site

- <u>non-specific</u> area

eg,

temporal lobe, Rt 3rd rib - location cranium, thoracic - site

Assessment/Evaluation

Assessment

- objective observation and measurement
- <u>understand</u> the <u>state or condition</u> eg, malaria

E<u>valu</u>ation

- observation and measurement
- <u>judge and determine</u> its <u>value</u> eg, new treatment modality
