## Commas

- Univariate analysis showed that IBS was associated with pet ownership, antibiotic usage, late dinner (> 21:00 hour) and consumption of Western meals, coffee(,) and bread.
- In this context, recognized mechanisms in IBS span a wide spectrum including gut dysmotility, low-grade inflammation, visceral hypersensitivity, changes of gut microbiome, infections, altered gut barrier function, genetic and psychosocial factors --- JNM
- "Those who have slow transit constipation might gain benefits from newer agents to restore colonic function(,) including serotoninergic enterokinetic agents, and intestinal secretagogues"
-     - if no comma then the function would include the next context
$\rightarrow$ "agents" and "secretagogues" are "functions"

## Confusing terminology

## care/intervention/ therapy/treatment/

- "Care" - preventive care, primary care - broad idea
- "Intervention" - cardiac catheterization - specific
- "therapy" and "treatment" - synonymous


## shall be/will be

...shall be... (cf: ...will be...)
used sometimes in UK English in USA legal documents

AVOID "shall be"!

## ...can (could) be...

- "can" - ability or capability
"... our results shows that it can be..." 1\% ~ 99\%


## AVOID!

The Obstetrician and Gynecologist의 manuscript submission guidelines
"using absolute terms such as:" 'always, never, sole'
"using imprecise terms such as:"
'might, could, can, rare, uncommon, usually, often, strongly, important, good, bad'

## may be \& maybe

- may be (two words) might be, could be, or would be = possibly
- maybe (one word) = probably


## possible \& probable

- Possible - it could happen < 50\%
- Probable - more likely to happen > 50\%
"...our results show that the outcome is probably more favorable.... "


## who \& whom

... 35 patients were enrolled in this study, and

who/whom (?) showed that...

- Current English: use who


## ...comparison...

...Group A patients showed significant difference
"in comparison with"
VS
"compared to"

Group B patients...

## consist/comprise/composed

## "...our study group selection..." <br> - consisted of... <br> - comprised of... <br> - was composed of...

## corroboration \& collaboration

"...our results are in collaboration(?) with..."

Corroborate - agree with (확증하다)
Collaborate - work together (협력하다)

## Incidence/Prevalence/Frequency

Prevalence

- proportion of cases in the population at a given time
- indicates the disease widespread

Incidence

- information on risk of contracting disease
$\rightarrow$ prevalence $=$ incidence $\times$ duration

Frequency
number of occurrences of a repeating event per unit time

## Location/Site

## Location

- particular, specific point or place in physical space

Site

- non-specific area
eg,
temporal lobe, Rt $3^{\text {rd }}$ rib - location cranium, thoracic - site


## Assessment/Evaluation

Assessment

- objective observation and measurement
- understand the state or condition eg, malaria


## Evaluation

- observation and measurement
- judge and determine its value eg, new treatment modality
